

# MATHEMATICAL PUBLICATIONS FROM UCT

**MATHEMATICAL DIGEST**, a quarterly magazine produced by the Department of Mathematics and Applied Mathematics of the University of Cape Town, was first published in 1971. Its target readership was high school pupils who enjoy mathematics and wanted to widen their horizons in the subject as a preparation for university study. It enjoyed a wide circulation in (and outside) South Africa. The magazine ceased publication with the October 2014 issue (number 177). About 50 back numbers, mainly the more recent editions, are still available.

**THE UCT MATHEMATICS COMPETITION** attracts over 7000 participants every year. The Yearbooks contain the problems, full solutions, statistics and results of this popular event. They provide excellent practice for those interested in taking part in maths competitions, including the national South African Mathematics Olympiad. They are also good preparation for the National Benchmark Test in Mathematics.

**A MATHLETE'S TRAINING GUIDE** is recommended for maths competition beginners in grades 8 and 9.

## SOUTH AFRICA AND THE INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICS OLYMPIAD

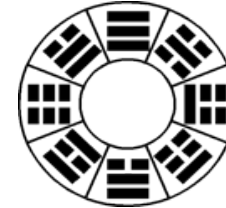
